#### WELCOME AIRPORT COUNTER

Wearing mask is compulsory Hand sanitizer dispenser at your disposal

Scan our QR code to download Mautourco Mobile App . We highly recommend that you use this device for assistance during your stay

## YOUR TRANSFER

Vehicles are sanitized after each transfer

Temperature check \* of guest before starting each journey

Hand sanitizer are at your disposal Face mask is compulsory

### **YOUR STAY**

Manage your meeting with your dedicated hotel representative via the mobile App

Follow the mandatory sanitary requirements (such as wearing of mask, social distancing, body temperature check) prior to engaging into any activity

## **TOURS**

All suppliers have been assessed and meet local sanitary protocols

Temperature check \* before each tour Mask compulsory

Cashless transactions are encouraged Briefing for each activity before tour Please read carefully disclaimers and policies for each tour

## GENERAL RULES

\*Temperature Checks:

When temperature of 37.8 or more is identified, access to the vehicle/ premises will be refused and guest will immediately be referred to the nearest local health office.

Temperature check\* before entering your departure transfer to airport and by local authorities before take off of flight
